



Reed City Park and Lake will be open for fishing starting April 1st. **Permit sales begin March 21st.** All fishermen over 16 need to have a valid State of Illinois Fishing License *AND* a permit issued by Hollis Park District. Please visit the Hollis Recreation Center for the rules,



regulations and to purchase your permit. You may pre-register online to make purchasing permits easier! *Proof of Residency Required.* Fishing allowed on Wednesday for Seniors/Veterans and Friday through Sunday for others.

Permits are FREE for Residents. \$50 Non-Resident Senior/Veteran, \$75 Non-Resident Adult or Non-Resident Senior/Veteran Couple, \$125 Non-Resident Adult Couple, \$25 Weekend Pass, \$10 Adult Day Pass, & \$5 Senior Day Pass.
