



2024 FISHING PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

No person shall take or attempt to take any fish from any body of water located on Park District property unless such person is in possession of a current State of Illinois fishing license **and** a fishing permit issued by Hollis Park District. For all permits a Photo ID is required. For proof of residency 2 forms of ID are required: Photo ID **and** a Utility Bill or Tax Bill. Couples must reside at the same address **and** have proof of cohabitation.

No person shall transfer or loan a fishing permit to another person. Such transferal or loan shall result in confiscation of the fishing permit and may warrant citation.

No person in possession of a valid fishing permit shall host, as guest, a person to fish on any body of water located on Park District property until such guest is in possession of a '**HPD Guest Pass**' fishing permit. Such hosting of unauthorized guests may result in citation to the hosting party.

Persons possessing such a permit may fish in Reed City Lake subject to the following restrictions:


- 1. NO MINNOWS shall be used as bait**
- 2. No fishing shall be done other than with a pole and line.**
- 3. Maximum of two poles per fisherman.**
- 4. Limits Of Fish Taken In 1 Calendar Day By One Person**

| c. Walleye: 18 inches or longer | Limit 1 |

| e. Crappies: 9 inches or longer | Limit 5 |
| f. Redear | Catch & Release |
- 5. No Grass Carp or Frogs shall be taken at any time.**
- 6. No person shall take or attempt to take any fish at any time other than during the following times: April 1st – October 31st 7am–Dusk (When the lake ramp light comes on)**
 - Friday, Saturday, Sunday
 - Holidays: Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day.
 - Wednesdays 7am–Dusk (**When the lake ramp light comes on**) for those with a **Senior Permit** and 1 guest under the age of 55 with a HPD permit or guest pass.
 - Children under the age of 16** may fish without a permit **and** must be accompanied by an Adult who has an HPD fishing permit.
 - Ice Fishing between 7:00am – 5:00pm on Saturday and Sundays during November-March weather permitting and provided the park has posted as open for ice fishing.
- 7. No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed.**
- 8. Trolling Motors only.**
- 9. No Swimming or Wading.**
- 10. Permits and guest passes may be purchased at the Hollis Recreation Center during staffed hours.**
